What is in it for me?

The winning team (based on the outcomes and the presentation on the final day) will win an entry ticket to the EIT Health Summit in Lodz, Poland (4-5th Dec 2018) and all reasonable T&A costs will be reimbursed up to a maximum of 800€ per team (teams from Poland) and 1600€ per team (teams from other European countries).

How much will it cost me?

Registration and participation are completely free for all participants (but participants will be selected based on merit only). Moreover, all meals during the hackathon are covered. Reasonable T&A expenses will be reimbursed up to a maximum of 150€ pp (participants from Germany) and 400€ pp (participants from other European countries).

How do I apply?

All applications should be addressed to Mohammad Chehadé and submitted via email to this address: clc.germany@eithealth.eu. Applications should be written in English, should include a short motivation and a CV. Having publications in the field is encouraged.

Students, doctors and anyone who is directly or indirectly related to the field of health in general and AMR specifically is more than welcome to send their application. The hackathon language will be English thus you must have excellent command of the language. The more languages you speak the merrier (Polish, Spanish, French, German, Dutch are particularly interesting in the context)!
